

Registration is open for DSUL 2010.

Games will be on Thursday evenings at the Schaefer Athletic Complex (at Hampden and Kipling) and will begin on June 3<sup>rd</sup> with our last set of regular-season games being on August 5<sup>th</sup>. Playoffs will then be on Saturday, August 7<sup>th</sup> there at Schaefer. Please circle (or check if registering online) the appropriate response to the question on the registration form relative to your being available for Playoffs or not. We will not have what we had been using as Fields 1 and 2 this summer, so there will be a re-alignment and subsequent renumbering of the fields for DSUL 2010. As a result of the field closure, we will only have 8 fields this summer. All 8 fields, however, will be on the same side of the complex. Please refer to the map on the reverse for how the fields will be laid out and numbered or look at the Map to Fields link online.

The manual draft will be in place. Drafting Captains (D/C's) will be needed. The drafts will take place at the Buckhorn Exchange Restaurant and Saloon on Tuesday evening, May 11<sup>th</sup> for the B division, followed by the A-division draft on Thursday evening, May 13<sup>th</sup>. Compensation for volunteering to be a D/C will be the D/C's having their appetizers and beverages of choice paid for on draft night.

Draft registration fees are (again) on a tiered system. A \$65 registration fee is in place until midnight, April 11<sup>th</sup>. A \$75 registration fee is in place from April 12<sup>th</sup> until midnight, April 18<sup>th</sup>. The registration fee then increases to \$85 from April 19<sup>th</sup> until midnight, April 25<sup>th</sup>. Registration will officially close after midnight on April 25<sup>th</sup>. Players are urged to register online (at [www.dsul.org](http://www.dsul.org)) as opposed to registering via snailmail. Please note that the registration fee increases mentioned above reflect midnights on Sundays if registering online. If you insist on registering via snailmail, those fee increases reflect **Saturday** postmark deadlines. That is, fees increase for postmarks after April 10<sup>th</sup> and April 17<sup>th</sup>. No snailmail registration forms will be processed having a postmark after April 24<sup>th</sup>.

If you are registering online, please fill out all fields, specifically your full address, including city and zip code. Next year's registration mailing is built from this year's registration data. Failure to include your full address this year will result in your not getting next year's registration information. The same goes for snailmail registration; please fill out all requested information, especially the Number of Years Played Ultimate.

Those players interested in having their artwork considered for the DSUL 2010 shirts and discs are encouraged to contact me at the e-mail address shown below. I'm already thinking of something space related (think the movie '2010'). Some possible ideas might be something along the lines of the design including/depicting 7 astronauts and a disc in space, or possibly a couple astronauts holding pint glasses milling around a keg, or, appropriately enough, 7 astronauts being awed by a keg/monolith.

There will still be no dogs allowed on or near the sidelines. Dogs brought to the fields will have to be tethered at the end of the field, beyond the end of the end zone. This will be strictly enforced. Losses (forfeits) will be assigned to the team that any individual belongs to that does not comply with this rule.

A few notes:

- All players will get a 2010 DSUL disc and shirt.
- Cups will not be provided. If you like what I bring, please bring your own cup.
- Please remember to pick up your belongings after your game. The DSUL does not conduct a lost and found.
- Playoffs are Saturday, August 7<sup>th</sup> at Schaefer Athletic Complex, so mark your calendars now.
